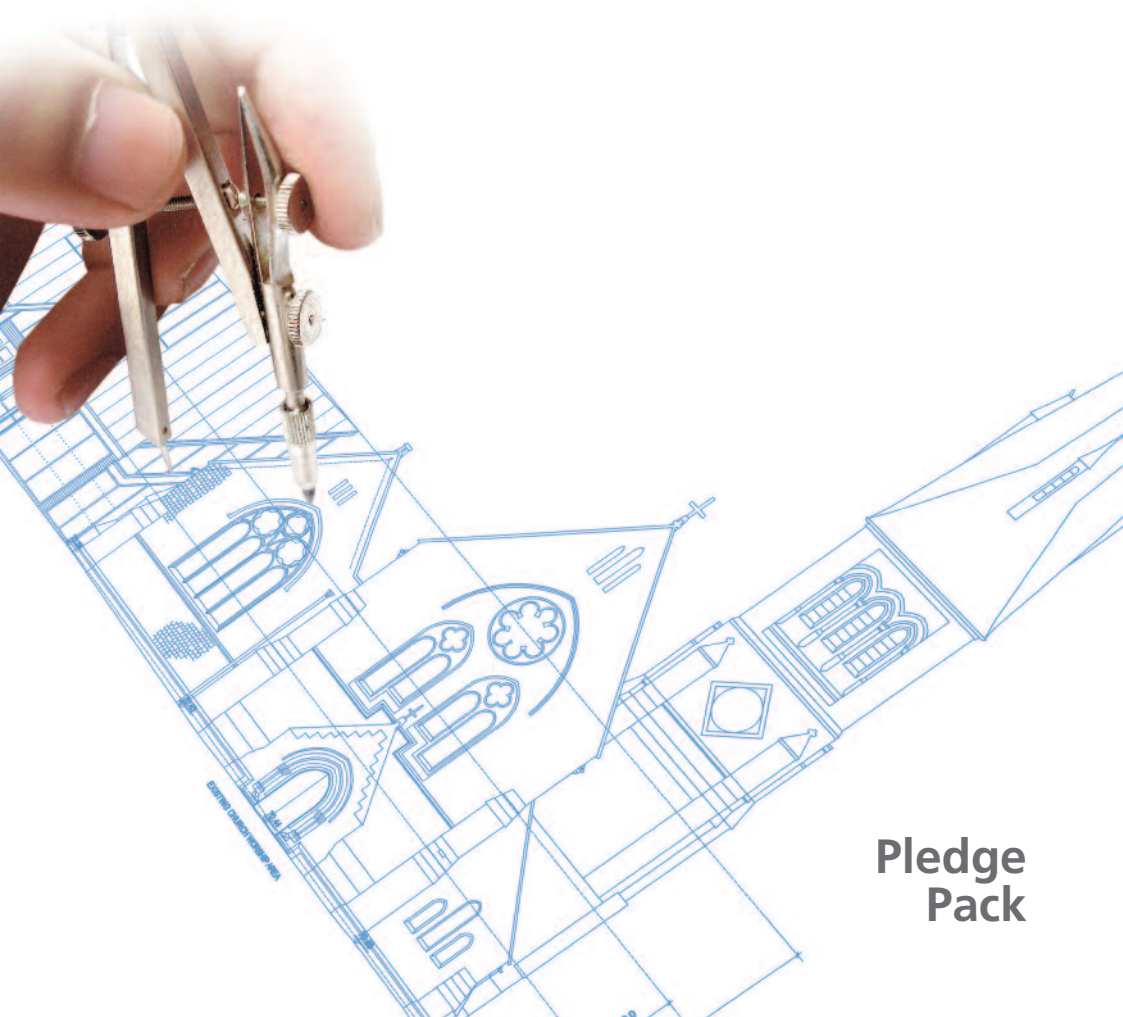

**Pledge
Pack**

As you will have heard, we have now received planning permission and are launching the Capital Campaign for the Site Redevelopment Project, known as CONNECT. We have an exciting vision to take our church into the future, putting Jesus at the centre of this community and our wider region. Physically, we want to connect our buildings together into one attractive and connective complex. Philosophically, we want to make the most of the mission opportunities that we gain through serving the local community by connecting what we do mid-week with what happens on Sundays. Spiritually, we want to connect with each other and with the local community by fostering much deeper relationships through making the church a meeting place.

The purpose of this Pledge Pack is to ask you to consider prayerfully how you are going to respond to this challenge. You will see that there are several ways that you can give to the project. We appreciate that these are difficult times for many and that there is a feeling of great uncertainty about the future. This gives us an opportunity to develop a faith community that runs counter to the spirit of the age and shows the love and power of our God. I want to ask you to take this pack away with you and to pray over your response, based on the knowledge that you have about the project and the needs of the church. We want to grow and develop, not just to meet current needs but the future vision of a regional and resourcing centre.

There is so much we have to be thankful for in this community that we serve and through this project we have the chance to demonstrate the love of God both here and through the linked projects that we want to support around the world. We will need to give generously, even sacrificially, but you will be amazed at how much you can do over three or more years. You will be even more amazed at what God can do when he finds a heart that wants to be generous. Please come to one of the Pledge Sunday services with your completed Pledge Pack so that we can get on as quickly as possible with building the church that God has called us to become.

How can I give to CONNECT?

There are six main ways to give:

- 1 By one-off donation*
- 2 Regularly by bank standing order*
- 3 In the form of quoted shares and certain other securities
(This entitles you to tax relief)
- 4 Through Stewardship Services, Charities Aid Foundation Giving and other similar schemes
- 5 Through your employer's payroll giving scheme
(This only applies if your employer runs such a scheme)
- 6 In the form of time and efforts toward fundraising

**If you pay UK tax (Income or Capital Gains Tax) and would like us to be able to claim back the basic rate tax, you will need to fill in the ongoing Gift Aid declaration at the back of this booklet. The benefit to All Saints' is that we can recover 28p of tax for each pound you give (reduces to 25p from April 2011).*

If you are a higher rate tax payer and complete a Self Assessment Return, make sure you include the gross total of all Gift Aid Donations as this is how you claim the higher rate relief.

What should I do now?

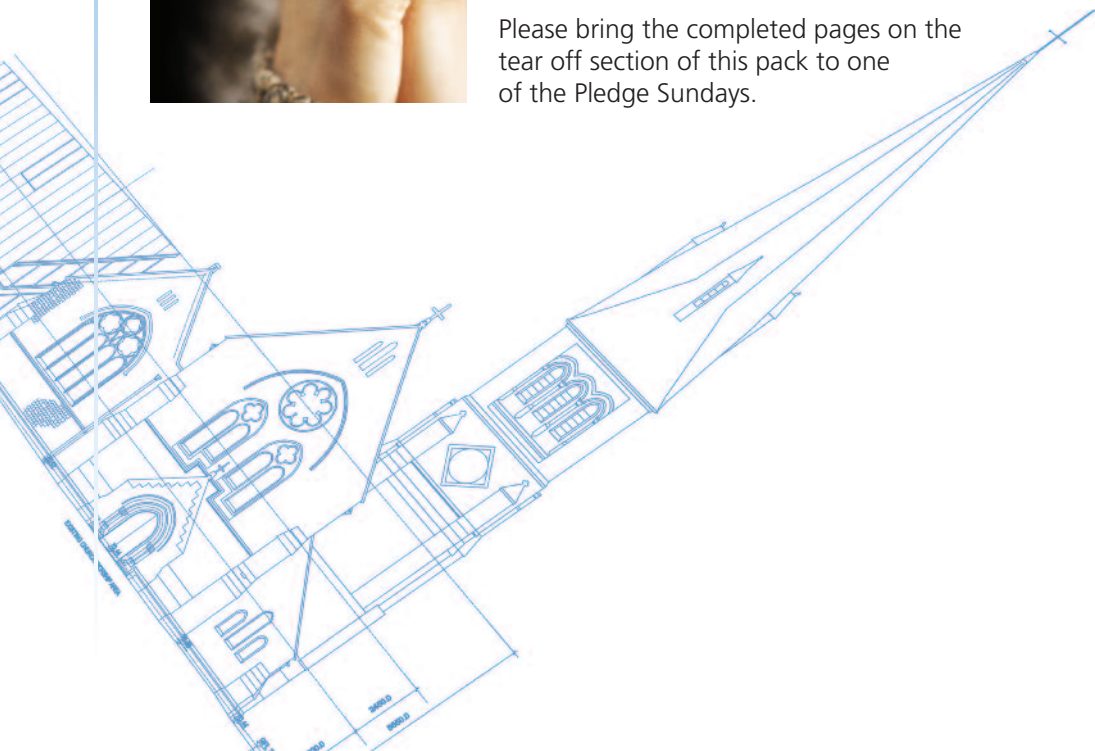
TAKE STOCK and think carefully about your finances. If you haven't carried out a recent check of your assets and liabilities please consider carefully their real values and examine your income and expenditure carefully. There are many simple guides to help you such as *The Money Revolution* which is available at the back of church.

PLAN AHEAD and consider all the options and possibilities open to you. We identified six main ways that we believe people may be able to give. Choose those that you believe God is leading you to and read the information in the Pledge Pack on how to give. More than that, though, think about the different ways you can give beyond financial giving; through prayer and through supporting fundraising efforts.



PRAY that God will speak to you and lead you as you consider the next steps. Those with joint accounts may find it best to set a time when they can come together to discuss what they believe God is saying. Be prepared to listen to Him and be open to His challenge to you. Don't pledge or give out of fear or guilt. God loves a cheerful giver who wants us to give out of love and commitment to Him.

You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying us.

You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).

If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your self-assessment tax return.

If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for gift Aid tax relief, please contact us or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR65 Gift Aid.

If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you can cancel your declaration (see first note above).
